New Chair address and introduction of new terms of reference Cllr. Sandy Walkington, Chair thanked those present and the steering group. At last year's AGM a proposal was put forward to review the current constitution and make it fit for purpose in the present day.

The Chair went through the new Terms of Reference and gave an opportunity for those present to comment.

A query was made on how the chair and vice chair are voted.

The clarification is that the steering group elect the chair and vice chair. At AGM's / special meetings where there is a need to vote on matters arising, all stakeholders (one vote per organisation / group) are eligible to vote.

The Chair asked if the new terms of reference could be adopted. This was approved with no objections and seconded.

The new Terms of Reference for the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership was adopted on 27th June 2022.
