Terms and Conditions

1. To enter the prize draw (the "Prize Draw") you must complete the [2024 Abbey Line survey](#) and submit your name and email address. No purchase is necessary.
2. The prize draw is open to people aged 18 and over who provide their email address after completing the survey.
3. Entrants into the Prize Draw shall be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions and are eligible to claim any prize they may win.
4. Only one entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
5. The closing date of the Prize Draw is the same as the closing date of the survey. Entries received outside this time period will not be considered. The survey opens on 1st May 2024 and closes on July 14th 2024.
6. Five winners will be chosen from a random draw of entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. The draw will take place on 15th July 2024.
7. The winners will receive a £20 voucher for Tea for Two at the Tea Room at Bricket Wood and two return rail tickets to Bricket Wood station from any other Abbey Line station of their choosing.
8. The winners will be notified by email within a month after the prize draw is held. If a winner does not respond to the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership within 14 days of being notified by the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership shall be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above (and that winner will have to respond to notification of their win within 14 days or else they will also forfeit their prize). If a winner rejects their prize or the entry is invalid or in breach of these Terms and Conditions, the winner's prize will be forfeit and the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership shall be entitled to select another winner.
9. The prize will be sent to the winner by the Abbey Line Community Rail Partnership by post or email.
